Gilles Couture

The Greater Sudbury Police Service is asking for the public's assistance in locating a missing person.

Gilles Gerard Couture, 57 years of age, was last seen on Wednesday, August 6th, 2008. He was reported missing after he failed to show up for a golf date he had with his brother. Mr. Couture was planning a trip to Ottawa with the same brother the following week and was looking forward to the trip.

Mr. Couture took the keys to his apartment but left behind his wallet, bank card, credit card, keys to his car and his golf clubs. There was no sign of a struggle or anything amiss in his apartment and his car was parked in the garage at his apartment building. There have been no withdrawals from his bank account since his disappearance.

Mr. Couture has worked for the same taxi company for the last four or five years, working long hours in the winter and taking vacation time and golfing during the summer months.

On the surface Mr. Couture seemed to be a happy go lucky person though there is some indication that he may have been depressed at the time of his disappearance.
